Who are Transgendered People?

‘Transgendered people—A nebulous category that can include anyone who crosses gender boundaries, regardless of whether that crossing is permanent or intentional; anyone who exhibits characteristics of a gender that does not match their apparent physical sex.’

James Green, *President, FtM International*

Transgendered people identify themselves as:

Cross-dresser:

A person who enjoys wearing clothes identified with the opposite gender. Often, but not always, straight according to their gender of birth.

Transvestite:

The original name for a cross dresser.
From the Latin - trans: across, and veste: to dress.

Transsexual:

A person whose sexual identity is the opposite to their assignment at birth. Not all transsexual people undergo sex-reassignment-surgery (SRS) for various reasons including personal preference or for health or financial reasons.

Intersex:

A person born with mixed sexual physiology. Often (surgically) reassigned at birth. Such practice is coming under well-founded attack as a hurtful invasion of a person’s well being. The more progressive approach of waiting until the natural gender becomes apparent is more widely used today so that the person affected can make their own choice at an age where their true, natural, gender becomes apparent.

Androgyne:

A person appearing and identifying as neither man nor woman, presenting a gender either mixed or neutral.

Transgenderist:

Person who lives as the gender opposite to anatomical sex, i.e. a man living as a woman but retaining the male genitals and sexual function.

Drag-Queen:

A female-emulating exhibitionist male. Usually displaying a camp manner. Often, but not always, gay. Often associated with the stage.

Drag-King:

A male-emulating woman.

Butch:

Masculine appearing person, usually of the female gender.

Femme:

Feminine appearing person—usually male.
